Returning to School.

Dear Parent/Carer,

We have been working hard in preparation for the children's return tomorrow and can't wait to see them back. Just some final reminders before we welcome the children tomorrow:

- Our current exit and entrance points will be maintained (see below) at these times:

- Punctuality is vital when your child accesses their 50% allocation on Thursday and Friday this week, and will continue to be vital as we move forward. Please keep up the good work that we saw in July, in this area.
- No Parents or adults are allowed on site. Please make an appointment if you'd like to visit or give us a call.
- It is requested that only one parent or carer accompanies a child to school.
- Please park elsewhere and walk your child to school. Dropping off is no longer a safe option.
- The wearing of masks is voluntary rather than mandatory with children using transport from Monmouthshire CC who are under the age of 11. This is an amendment to the information I gave you on Monday.
- Children who are using transport will be led directly in to their classroom learning bubble and will be exempt from the staggered times (above). A staff member will be allocated to escort them safely on and off site.
- All children's attendance in September is "compulsory." Children need to back in to learn and for their wellbeing.
- We expect all children to be in full uniform unless there is a medical reason for them not to be.
- The children will have PE and games on the same day in the next half term (teachers will inform you through their newsletters when they have that timetabled). On that day, your child will be free to wear their PE kit in to school, covered with a tracksuit top and/or bottoms if the weather demands it.
- School dinners will be available through "grab bags" that will be delivered to your child's class, where they will be consumed. Packed lunches, that have clear labels on them, can be sent in with a small bag, but if you can avoid this, please do. The less though, we would encourage you to just send in the lunchbox and drink bottle.
- No water bottles will be allowed to be refilled on site (unless there is an emergency). Please fill them at home with water only (we are a healthy school) and make sure that they are labelled very clearly.
- We would ask that we continue with only one adult, walking, to drop a child off, wherever possible.
- Children do NOT have to line up at a distance of 2 metres apart on previously sprayed out markings, whilst lining up at our school gates. Adults, however, should maintain social distancing at all times whilst dropping off and collecting children.
- Children should not mix with other classes as they line up. They should stay in class bubbles as enter & exit school.
- It is absolutely vital that you do not send in your child if they are displaying any symptoms of Covid-19 and that you call us to let us know. Similarly, we would expect the same if household members have been told their symptoms demand self-isolation.
- All children will be provided with stationery in class. Please don't send in pencil cases, as you otherwise might. They will have pouches with equipment that only they will use.
